Keith Parr
Christopher Newport University

Head Coach for Christopher Newport University since 2004 and was assistant from 2000-2003. Has compiled a 186-71-1 record over his six seasons as head coach. Has three regular season Conference Championships and two USA South Tournament titles. He was Coach of the Year in 2004, 2007 and 2009. He has also been named as State Coach of the Year in Virginia. 2010 was CNU's greatest softball year in history. The Lady Captains won the Regional Tournament advancing them to the Division III World Series where they were eliminated in the Semi-Finals.



Chip Bailey
Christopher Newport University

Has been the Assistant Coach for the CNU softball team for the past four seasons, where he has helped lead the team to three conference championships as well as their greatest year in CNU history, making it to the semi-finals in the Division III World Series. For the past ten years, he has taught summer softball camps and numerous fielding and hitting clinics across Virginia. Helped coach Richmond based travel team The Sports Plus, won primarily ASA Tournaments and many of his players have gone on to play collegiate softball.



Loren Messick
Radford University

Entering her second year as Assistant Coach of the Radford University Softball Team. 2010 season ended by winning the Big South Tournament Title and earning a regional berth. They lost their first game in the regionals and went through the losers bracket to make it to the championship game where they lost to the University of Georgia. Messick was a standout at Roanoke College where she was a four-time OMAC selection at shortstop. She won two OMAC Championships in 2005 and 2006 and earned regional bids both seasons, where they reached the finals in 2006. They were 100-38 in Messick's four years in uniform. She is ranked in the top ten for sacrifice hits (2nd), batting average (5th), assists (5th), hits (7th), and runs (7th). She is also ASA Deputy 3D Commissioner in the Roanoke Area.



Kristy Norton
James Madison University

Associate Head Coach at JMU, where she has been since 2005. She works primarily with the team's infielders and hitters. In 2007, she helped lead JMU to their best offensive season in programs history setting new season marks for batting average, slugging percentage, runs scored, homers and RBI's. She helped coach JMU's first CAA Co-Player of the Year that year as well. Norton was a All-Southern Conference and honorable mention All-South second baseman during her playing career at UNC Greensboro. She is second on UNC-G's career lists for hits and doubles and fifth in runs batted in.



Dana Wood
Randolph Macon College

Five Seasons as an Assistant Coach at Randolph-Macon. In 2007, helped lead the program to their best yet in the 10-year history of the program. They also earned their first berth in the OMAC postseason Tournament. He was a big part in helping bring fast-pitch softball to Ashland Little League. He has also coached Patrick Henry High School and helped them capture the Colonial District Title in 2006 and 2007. He played baseball at Randolph-Macon.



Erin St. Ledger
East Carolina University

A former ECU 4-year starter at second base. In 2005, she was named to the C-USA All-Freshman team and All-Conference in 2006. Helped lead her team her senior year to their first ever NCAA Regional win against Mississippi Valley State University. Is in ECU record books for 10th in career doubles and 5th in walks.
